


A story to be felt, not just read.

Introducing **Sense Able Story**: A new way to experience storytelling that is calm, inclusive, and deeply engaging.

Rather than telling a child how to experience a story, a Sense Able Story invites them to discover it.



Sense Able Story



Our first journey begins with a gentle guide.

"Hello there, little adventurer! Before we begin our dander... we will need a few special treasures from the world around you."

"Nature is full of magic. A single leaf or a pinch of sand can change the way a page feels beneath your fingertips."



The Workshop: Steady, Slow, and Calm

The Story Moment

"Another day fixing spaceships, steady, slow, and calm. I'd eat more lunch, but honestly, it all goes straight to my shell and charm."



The Sensory Link

The smooth stone feels solid and steady, like the ground beneath my feet, while the fabric strap is firm but flexible, holding things safely in place.

The Audio Deepening



Features narration, soundscapes, and a song verse: *Slow hands, steady ground / Every bolt knows where it's bound...*

The Troposphere: Lighter Than Air



The Story Moment

"Oh, this is new, I'm off the ground, I seem to be airborne at last. And goodness me, the boosters work, we're rising rather fast."


The Sensory Link

Paper feels light and airy in my hands, while cotton is soft and floating, just like the sky carrying me upwards.

The Audio Deepening



The audio narration enhances the sense of wonder and gentle surprise. The song verse reflects the new sensation: *Something's lifting me away / Feet aren't where they were today...*



The Mesosphere: A Flash in the Dark

The Story Moment

"Oh look, a meteor flashing by, it's glowing, fast, and hot. It didn't stop to say hello, it simply zoomed and shot."

The Sensory Link

Ribbon twists and moves quickly, while foil flashes and shines, like something hot and fast streaking through the dark.

The Audio Deepening



The accompanying audio uses subtle sound effects and a slightly more up-tempo musical cue to represent the meteor's flight.

The Moon: A Soft and Dusty Landing



The Method Behind the Magic.



A Sense Able Story is a carefully designed methodology
for creating multi-sensory reading experiences.

It is built on six core principles that ensure every story
is calm, curious, and accessible to all.

The Six Principles of Sense Able Storytelling.



Sensory, Not Prescriptive

Invites children to touch, listen, and imagine. There is no single 'correct' outcome.




Accessible by Design

Accessibility is built in from the beginning, not added as an afterthought.



The World as a Resource

Uses simple, familiar materials, turning the environment into part of the story.



Story First, Technology Second

Technology is supportive, never dominant. Attention remains on the page.



Rhythm, Humour, and Warmth

Gentle rhyme and kind humour create a safe, reassuring experience.



Calm, Curious, and Non-Competitive



Values slow moments, gentle discovery, and shared attention over speed or performance.

Accessible by Design means it works for everyone.

The books are not marketed as 'special needs' products because they are designed for universal enjoyment from the ground up. This means:

- Children who cannot read can fully experience the story through audio.
- Children with sensory differences can engage through touch and sound.
- Children who enjoy crafting or outdoor discovery are naturally included.
- Adults and carers can adapt the experience easily without specialist training.


An invitation for every kind of reader.

No prior ability is assumed. No diagnosis is required.





A flexible format with powerful potential.

While the physical books are simple, much of the content lives in the accompanying layers. This makes the format:

- **Flexible:** Adaptable to many stories and settings.
- **Affordable:** Production relies on simple materials and digital assets.
- **Scalable:** The methodology can be applied to create an entire series.

Each book is intentionally short, designed to be returned to again and again, rather than 'finished' and forgotten.

The journey is just beginning.



Sense Able Story is a method of storytelling, not a single book. Each new story introduces a new guide and a new adventure, built on the same core principles.

Coming soon:

- A sea serpent on a gentle walk.
- A pigeon ruling rooftops with pride and humour.

Different worlds, same principles. Every story is an invitation.

Smile at the strange bits. Enjoy the quiet moments.

Life won't always ask what you had planned; it might just press play. When it does; watch what happens... You never know where you might end up, or who you might **meet along the way**. And that can be rather **wonderful**.
